

“LET US PREVENT FROM COVID 19”

GUIDELINES FOR VISITORS AND READERS DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL MUSEUMS

Dear Visitors & Readers, please follow all the hygienic measures outlined below.

1. It is mandatory for visitors to wash hands at least for 20 seconds before entering the museum premises. Facilities are provided at the entrance.
2. Use the sterilized door mat to properly disinfect the shoes before entering the museum.
3. Wearing a proper face mask is mandatory.
4. Cover your cough and sneeze using bent elbow or using a tissue.
5. Refrain from entering the museum premises if you suffer from fever, cough, cold or any other respiratory disorders.
6. Maintain 1 meter distance between yourself and others.
7. To minimize exchange of money try to pay the exact amount of the ticket value at the ticket counters.
8. Each visitor should retain his/her ticket throughout the museum visit
9. Forward the ticket individually to the museum staff (checker) when entering the museum.
10. To minimize crowding, only 10 visitors will be allowed to enter the premises at a time.
11. Visitors are advised to use the hand sanitizers provided at the entrance of each museum.
12. Refrain from touching museum objects, sign boards, pedestals and electric appliances.
13. Try to minimize the use of staircase hand railing.
14. Try to avoid close contact with each other.
15. Do not dispose masks, gloves and tissues within the museum premises.
16. Use separate entry and exit doors.
17. In order to maintain a database, all visitors are advised to provide your personal information (Name, NIC/Passport & Contact details etc) to the museum staff

18. Refrain from having meals inside the museum premises.
19. It is mandatory to readers wear gloves when entering the library and don't try to dispose the gloves within the museum premises.
20. Refrain from using mobile phones, tabs and other digital devices inside the library.
21. Readers are advised to bring necessary stationery when visiting the library as such will not be provided by the library.
22. Readers are allowed to refer one reading material at a time.
23. Handbags, briefcases, helmets and jackets are not allowed in to the library.
